

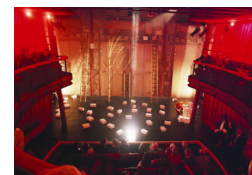
The eggpot fund supports ticket discounts for egg performances, bursary places at regular YPT groups and weekend workshops for disadvantaged youngsters as well as extending the community and education projects around the region. It helps young people who would benefit from the egg experience, but who are unable to do so because of social, financial or geographical circumstances. For example:

- The egg worked with Youth Services on a youth crime prevention project in Timsbury. The eggpot extended it by enabling the young people to visit a professional recording studio in Bath and recording a lyric they had written themselves which they could then play on their mobile phones and pass on to their friends, thus increasing the impact of the original project and reaching more young people.
- The egg has established Young Company, a new drama group for young people under threat of exclusion, which is supported by the Arts Council. The eggpot enabled them to attend additional workshops by paying travel costs and workshop fees, thus increasing their participation in positive activities and encouraging them to succeed in something outside school.
- Members of the Peasedown and Timsbury youth group were working towards an appearance in the Teenage Kicks Dance Festival, but their Youth Club was crowded and noisy. The eggpot paid for them to visit a professional dance space with proper facilities which enabled them to be better prepared and more clearly focused before their performance at the egg.

How you could help:

- £15 would enable a young person and their parent or carer to enjoy a Saturday performance in the egg, without having to worry about the cost of the bus fare or the theatre ticket
- £60 would enable a young person to take part in four sessions of our monthly play-in-a-day workshop for 8 to 12 year olds
- £180 would enable a young person to take part for a year in our after-school drama group for 5 – 12 year olds offering performance opportunities in the egg
- £1,000 would establish a weekly pre-school drama group in a rural setting
- £5,000 would establish a new youth theatre company for disabled young people

The ambitions of the eggpot are defined by how much money is contributed to it. The greater the funds, the greater the opportunities that can be offered to young people who would most benefit. Thank you.
