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There are songs in the play and recorded music which Katherine and Billy sing along to. It has been specially written for the play. If it ever feels too loud for you, you can cover your ears or put your ear defenders on.



There is also a puppet in the show. His name is Gus and he is made out of found objects. You can see his body is a basket, his feet are a pair of gloves, and his head is an upside down gravy boat. He honks to speak, but it isn't too loud.

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It is fine to talk to the people you are sitting with about what is happening on stage but if you try and talk to Katherine or Billy during the show, they won't be able to answer you because they will be busy acting out the story.

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At the end of the play, the audience may clap to show they have enjoyed watching. You can join in if you want to.
