Before arrival

Tickets

It may be easier to distribute your tickets amongst your party before you arrive, as our Main House and Ustinov foyers are small. The Egg Theatre's Café is a larger space where parties can wait more comfortably.

All tickets must be shown on entry. If it is not possible to print and distribute e-tickets to all members of the group please ensure that the person at the head of the party has all the tickets for their group in an easily readable format as they will need to show them on their seating level.

Arrival

In the auditorium

The auditoria usually open 30 minutes prior to the start of the performance for the Main House, opening times for The Ustinov and The Egg times may vary. The performance time on your ticket is when the performance will start.

How to find us

The Theatre Royal Bath is located on Sawclose between Barton Street and Monmouth Street in central Bath, BA1 1ET.

The Theatre Royal site comprises: The Main House theatre, Ustinov Studio theatre, The Egg theatre, The Egg café, The Garrick's Head pub and the 1805 rooms.



Car \ Coach

Parking

Parking is limited in the immediate vicinity of the Theatre. The nearest large car park is Charlotte Street which is less than 10 minute walk away via Queens Square. There is also a large underground car park at Southgate Shopping Centre.

Coach Drop off

Coach drop off is available at Queen Square by the Francis Hotel.

NOTE: Sawclose is now pedestrianised for large parts of the day so access via road for vehicles may be unavailable.

Public transport

The Bath Spa train and bus stations are a brisk 10 minute walk (or short taxi ride away).

With the Southgate Centre to your left, walk straight up Manvers Street. Just after the Abbey, turn left into Cheap Street/Lower Borough Walls. At the end of the road, turn right onto Barton Street and Theatre is a few paces up and on your

Access facilities

Toilets

Wheelchair

Main House: There are up to 8 wheelchair spaces located on the Stalls and Royal Circle levels.

Ustinov Studio: There are up to 2 wheelchair spaces available at Stalls level. These can be booked from Box Office on **01225 448844**.

The Egg: There are up to 8 wheelchair spaces available - 4 on each side of the auditorium. These can be booked in advance by phoning The Egg reception on 01225 823409.

Infra-red Hearing Enhancement

If you find it challenging to hear the dialogue during the performances, we have infrared headphones available free of charge from any of the Theatre bars to increase the dialogue level for you. Please note, there is no hearing loop accessible via patrons' own hearing aids.
