What to Expect




Snow Mice! is a play. A play is a story told by people acting on stage. This play has 3 performers.



Snow Mice! will have live music, sound effects and lights to help tell the story. Sometimes it might be loud or it might get dark, but not for very long.



play follows The three children who have just moved house and the whole play takes place in their new house and outside in their garden.



Snow Mice! is 1 hour long with no interval and takes place in the Egg Auditorium. We have a Visual Story available for the theatre if you're curious about your visit.

The Characters



Megan

This character is the oldest child in the family and doesn't like the new house.

She's a teenager and can be quite moody and sometimes teases her siblings.

She wears pyjamas while at home and a trendy green puffer coat and a big fluffy blue hat while outside.

You'll see Megan bossing her siblings around and playing the Ukelele (like a small guitar)



Juilette

This character is booksmart, wellspoken and kind and is the middle child in the family. When at home she wears a chequered set of red and purple pyjamas. When playing outside she wears a smart yellow coat, blue and white scarf and a purple beret. You'll see this character being obsessed with her books, being very brave and caring for her brother and sister.

The Characters



Timmy

This is the youngest member of the family, Timmy. He's boyish, sweet and a little clueless. He wears white green striped pyamas while at home and a blue coat and green hat while out adventuring.

You'll find this character asking lots of questions, being very sensitive and absolutely loving Snow!



The Musician

There is live music in the show, this means that the music you hear will be performed by a musician in front of you. The musician is very talented and plays multiple instruments during the show, he sometimes gets help from the other cast members too.

He wears a black suit, white shirt and a bowtie during the performance, this is called a tuxedo.

The Characters

The Snow Mice!







There are three Snow Mice in our production and you can tell them apart by their trousers. One wears red, one wears yellow and one wears blue.

These mice are bigger than your average mice, with all white fur, pink on their ears, hands, feet and noses and big black eyes.

The characters may seem frightened by the mice at first but they mean you no harm. These mice are cheeky, cute and very friendly.



The Stage Manager

During the show you may see the stage manager, either at the side of the stage or coming on to help move the set. They don't have a role in the story but play an important part in making the magic happen!

Things to look out for



Live Music

There are songs and live music in our production and often the characters will play instruments.



Flying

Things fall from the ceiling during the show. Sometimes snow, sometimes Mice, sometimes a little, sometimes a lot. In theatre this is called flying.



Puppets

The Snow Mice in our show are brought to life using puppets. These are controlled by the actors.



Our story begins with a thunder storm and heavy rain, there will be some loud sound effects but don't worry, you're completely safe.



Our main characters have just moved house and are struggling to settle in. They aren't very nice to each other but don't worry this is all pretend.



Timmy, the youngest, is the first to discover a Snow Mouse. Timmy and the Snow Mouse can be very silly and its okay to laugh.



Timmy and the Snow Mouse decide to go play out in the Snow and Timmy wants Snow Mouse to meet his sisters.



Timmy finds his sisters outside but the Snow Mouse has disappeared. Here they throw big snow balls into the audience, you can throw them back if you want to.



Megan and Juilette don't believe in Snow Mice and Timmy gets upset. They decide to build a Snow Mouse person to cheer him up.



After their hard work they head in for some toast. When Juilette returns alone she finds two Snow Mice playing in the snow and the three of them quickly become friends.



The Snow Mice disappear before Timmy and Megan return. They decide to go on an adventure to find them. (Even though Megan still doesn't believe)



On their adventure they come across a cravass (a big hole) they have to climb over. They fashion some rope out of clothes and set off through the audience (you might have to help them through.)



Megan loses Timmy and Juilette and is left all alone. Suddenly a huge avalache falls and covers Megan in snow!



The Snow Mice come to the rescue and save Megan. Megan is frightened at first but soon realises the Mice are friendly.



All three siblings and all three Snow Mice are united. With their adventure now complete they just need to figure out how to get home.



The set becomes a huge ski slope and miniature versions of Timmy, Juliette and Megan slide down towards their house.



They arrive back at the new house, finally accepting eachother and their new home.
